Open enrollment for 2018 health care coverage is quickly coming to an end for millions of Americans. Most people can find plans with monthly premiums less than \$75 thanks to the Affordable Care Act's tax subsidies and cost sharing reductions.

Open enrollment however has [faced many challenges](#) this year, including gutted funding and a shortened enrollment period. Despite these administrative setbacks, over [3.6 million Americans](#) have already selected a plan on the Marketplace.
